Fast Track to Reading Aloud Voorleesexpress

As a parent, do you find it difficult to help your child with language? Are you finding it difficult to read aloud as a parent? Then the Voorleesexpress is for you. A volunteer of Voorleesexpress will come to your home to help. Every week for six months. They will visit to read, talk and play games together. Your child will start to really enjoy reading and being involved with Dutch.

Vroeg- en Voorschoolse Educatie for children between
the ages of 2.5 and 4. This is a programme linked to
peuteropvang [toddler care] and at some childcare locations to offer extra help with the Dutch language and development.

Children learn while playing. This programme will help them to learn Dutch, to concentrate better and develop a larger vocabulary.

Where: at the peuteropyang (toddler care) organisation and at some childcare locations in the municipality of Maashorst.

The child healthcare centre and you can decide together whether your child would benefit from this.





Peuteropvang is there for children from the age of 2.5 up to and including the age of 4 years and 6 weeks. Children will be challenged to play and learn together. Attention: Children who already go to another regular childcare location will not receive an allowance for peuteropvang.

Peuteropvang is good for the development of your child. It ensures a better start at primary school. Trained employees will check how toddlers are developing and how they can best support toddlers.

Peuteropvang takes place twice during the morning or afternoon and will last 8 hours a week at most.

Where: at various locations in the municipality of Maashorst.

Costs: The costs depend on the income of parents.

The Peuteropyang organisation can make a calculation of the costs.


